

RULES OF THE CLUB

ETIQUETTE & DRESS

- Please treat the Clubhouse & Courts with respect.
- The Clubhouse & Courts should be left in a clean & tidy condition.
- Members waiting to play should remain outside the courts while play is in progress.
- The Clubhouse is a NO SMOKING area.
- Please leave the kitchen area clean and tidy with cups washed up after use.
- Players should dress in recognised Tennis or other sporting clothing.
- Tennis shoes must be worn. Heeled black soled shoes, boots or muddy trainers are not permitted as they damage the courts.
- The last person leaving the court is responsible for locking the gates and turning out the lights.
- If the clubhouse is not open the disabled toilet is accessible from the outside using the normal court key.
- Parents are expected to accept responsibility for the behaviour of, and any damage caused by,
 Junior members.

COURT BOOKINGS

- Courts may be booked for a maximum of 1½ hours at a time (other than for matches and tournaments).
- If a booked court is not in use 10 Minutes after the commencement of the booking time, rights to the court are lost, and it is available for use by any other member.
- Members must use the Court they have booked or delete the booking.
- Courts may be booked 1 WEEK IN ADVANCE using the Booking Page on the Club website.
- Adult members only may book Peak Time courts in advance.
 (Peak Times are 1800 2200 Monday to Friday and any time on Saturday & Sunday).
 Juniors may book available peak time courts on the day but not before.

GUESTS

- No person may be introduced as a playing guest on more than 6 occasions in any year.
- Members shall be responsible for the conduct of their guests whilst on the Club premises.
- Parents of Junior members are not permitted to hit with their children unless they are members.

KEYS

A key to the courts is issued to every adult member on joining the club. This key will enable entry to the courts, the floodlight cupboard and the disabled toilet. A replacement key is available to purchase at cost.

A key to the clubhouse can be allocated on request to a committee member, at a cost price of £10 refundable when no longer required.
